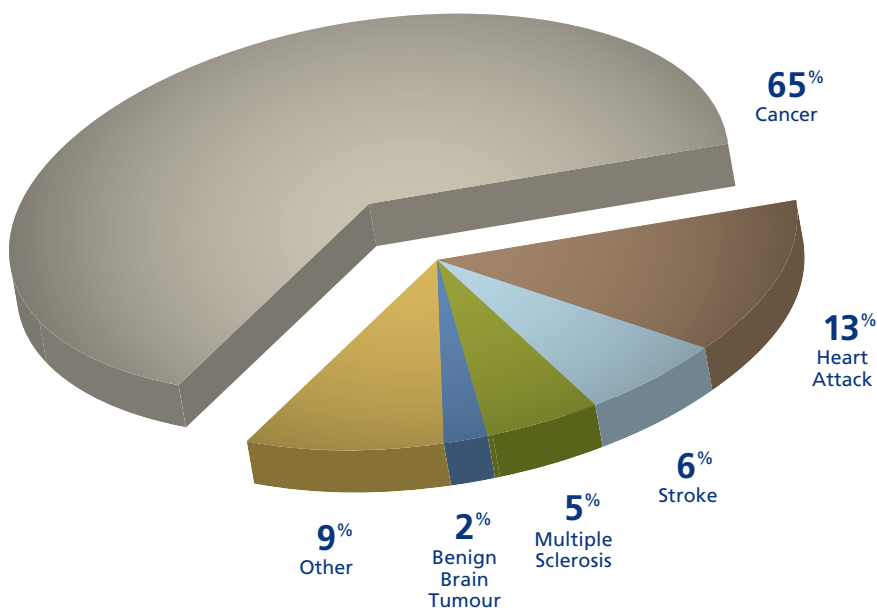

## Six months of critical illness claims paid – some interesting facts

- In January 2011, we paid over £250,000 to a chief executive who had prostate cancer
- In June 2011, we paid £400,000 to a managing director who had suffered a heart attack
- In June 2011, we paid over £160,000 to a child minder who had breast cancer and the plan had only been in force for eight months
- On average we paid £256,898 each day in critical illness claims
- In addition, we have also paid out over £560,000 on 30 children's critical illness claims. If ranked alongside our other causes for claim this would be the fourth highest reason for claim based on the number of claims received.
